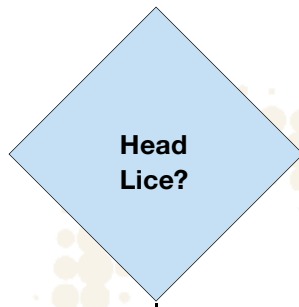


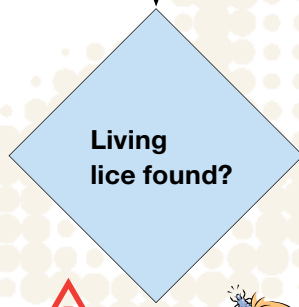


# Head Lice

## – what now?



Check **all members** of the family for **living lice** and **eggs/nits**.



**Yes**

**No**

**Eggs/nits found?**  
» Do **NOT** treat with anti-lice ointment  
» Check if head lice hatched from the eggs **every 3 days for two weeks.**

**No head lice or eggs/nits found?**  
» Do **NOT** treat with anti-lice ointment

Treat with an **effective lice ointment** according to **treatment plan** and **inform all contact persons**. Further measures are not necessary.

Day 1	<b>Treat with anti-lice ointment.</b>
Day 2	<b>Comb wet hair</b> to control if the product worked.
Day 5	Comb wet hair to prevent reinfection.
Day 8, 9 or 10	<b>Treat with anti-lice ointment</b> to kill hatched larvae.
Day 9, 10 or 11	<b>Comb wet hair</b> on the day after the treatment as a control if the product worked.



**Yes**

**No**

» **Control once per week** over a period of time to prevent further outbreaks of lice.  
» **After proper treatment**, remaining **eggs/nits** only cosmetically disturb the hair.

If you followed the **treatment plan correctly** and **used an effective anti-lice ointment**, then it is most probably a **new infection**.
