



Out of school childcare services

Overview for parents of what is on offer

Home-based childminder (Tagesfamilie)

Your child will be looked after in the childminder's home. Often childminders have their own children as well as providing childcare so your child may well be part of a family with other children to play with. You and your childminder agree on the times you need childcare to suit your needs.

Lunch club (Mittagstisch)

This service allows your child to eat lunch with other children and also enjoy the lunch break together. Children can go to lunch clubs every day of the week or just on certain days.

Out of school clubs (Schülerhort/Schülerclub)

Out of school clubs provide professional childcare for kindergarten and school-age children. The children and carers usually structure the time spent out of school in mixed age groups of approximately 20 children. Care can be for the full day from Monday to Friday, or on certain days, or just in the morning, at lunchtime or in the afternoon.

Day school/day kindergarten (Tagesschule/Tageskindergarten)

All the children stay at school or kindergarten from when the lessons start until they end (including over lunchtime). You can decide how to make use of the time periods set out by the school before lessons start or after they end.
